RENOVATIONS UPDATE

Our renovations are nearing completion. Our old recreation room is now closed to family use. Over the next few months it will be renovated into a physiotherapy room, an education room and an office for Katherina Luneng, our Spiritual and Social Care Coordinator.

Our dining room expansion is now complete and being used by residents during meal time, you are welcome to use it between meal times for visiting.

Our resident lounges have been constructed, but we are still waiting for the furniture to arrive any day. We have moved some temporary furnishings into the lounges and you are welcome to use these areas for visiting. One lounge is located across from the nursing station and one is located just down our Prairieland neighborhood on the right side.

Our new multi-purpose room is also complete, just a few paint touch up's are needed. You are welcome to use this area for visiting. This room is located just down our Prairieland neighborhood on the right side past the lounge.

To book the multi-purpose room for special occasions like birthday parties or anniversaries, please check with the Recreation staff or our Ward clerk. There is a \$25 booking fee which can be paid by cash, cheque or charged to your resident's account.

Our resident shower is almost complete, I anticipate that we will start using it in early May. Our residents will now have a choice between a tub bath and a shower.

Our new wheel chair accessible washroom is complete and already in use.

Our new staff room is mostly complete and already in use.

Our goal with these renovations was to create more living space for our residents, however we are not adding any more residents. So far the feedback I have received has been very positive.

The work outside the new multi-purpose room in our court yard includes replacing the side walk and patio that was torn out to make room for the building addition. This should be completed sometime in June depending on the weather. We will also have a lot of landscaping to do in the court yard after all the construction is complete.

Our next renovation goal is to add more resident rooms so we can increase the number of private rooms we have. I expect to have concept drawings within a year. It's an ambitious project that will cost a minimum of \$1.5 million with government support unlikely due to the difficult financial times we are in. If you would like to donate towards adding more resident rooms please come see Roger in the Business Office.

Lemon Poke Cake

- 2 white round cakes (9inch), cooled
- 2C. Boiling water
- 2Pkg. Lemon flavor Jello
- 1Pkg. Lemon flavor Pudding
- 1C. Cold milk
- 3C. Cool Whip thawed



Directions

1. Place cake layers top sides up, in 2 clean 9 inch round pans. With a large fork poke holes about 1/2 inch apart.
2. Add boiling water to gelatin mix; stir 2 mins until completely dissolved. Carefully pour over cakes. Refrigerate 3 hrs.
3. Beat pudding mix and milk in large bowl, add cool whip to the pudding. Dip first cake into warm water for about 10 seconds to unmold, place cake onto plate. Spread 1C. of pudding mixture on the first layer. Unmold second cake, top and frost with remaining mixture. Refrigerate 1 hour before serving.
